Special Education Software Update



EMIS (Education Management Information System) is the statewide data collection system for Ohio's primary and secondary education. Staff, student, district/building, and financial data are collected through this system. Staff data includes demographic, employment, attendance, and course information. Student data includes demographic, student attributes, attendance, program/membership, course, and test data in which all are submitted to ODE at the student level. General school district and school building data, including financial data, are also reported through EMIS. EMIS takes a
