Notes of the the meeting of the Technology Advisory Committee held July 2, 1997 at 2:30 p.m. The location of the meeting was Woodside School.

The following individuals were present for the meeting: Sewall Phelps (LC), Julia Smith (MA), Brian Edwards (NE), Cara Riddell (NE), Mary Blankestyn (NF), Ray Hetterscheidt (NR), Theresa Kucsma (SW), Dave Lewis (TRECA), Trish Baker (LACA) and Sandra Mercer (LACA). There was not a quorum.

Dave Lewis from TRECA (and SchoolNet Technical Faculty for the region) was introduced.

Brian Edwards and Cara Riddell presented information on the recent grant award from the SchoolNet office for Woodside to be one of the 13 state Technology and Learning Centers. Each member present received a copy of the grant proposal and award letter. A tour of the building followed. Discussion included each entities' participation in utilizing the building for professional development, development of policies and procedures that could fall under the responsibility of the LACATECH Advisory Committee, and how each entity could provide services to the overall goals of the Woodside implementation. Details included method of communication, equipment and network connections, acquiring facilitators, hours of operation, and definitions of building use. It was agreed that each member would post to the LACATECH listserv the following: ideas of how they see the facility being used and issues they feel will need to be addressed. This information will be used to develop a brochure for the Woodside facility and be the basis for the Center's utilization plan.
