# FY19 Changes

# Victim of Student Violence

- ▶ Classification of person(s) at whom a student's violent behavior was directed
- ▶ Now added to EMIS Manual Section 2.11: Student Discipline (GD) Record
- ▶ More options than originally expected

# Additional PS-3 Discipline Reason Detail

- ▶ New element (GD140): Reason for expulsion or out of school suspension
- ▶ Valid options
  - ▶ \* – Not applicable
  - ▶ A – ORC exemption
  - ▶ B – Immediate health and safety exemption
  - ▶ N – Neither exemption applies
- ▶ Added to EMIS Manual Section 2.11: Student Discipline (GD) Record

# Non-foster Court Placement

- ▶ New How Received (FS180) – Option D
- ▶ Example – resident of District A, court placed with relative in District B
  - ▶ District B reports
    - ▶ How Received (FS180) = D
  - ▶ District A reports
    - ▶ Sent Reason (FS200) = FC
- ▶ Also used when placed within resident district



# Open Enrolled Foster Student

- ▶ New How Received (FS180) – Option G
- ▶ Example – resident of District A, foster-placed to District B, open enrolled to District C
  - District C reports
    - How Received (FS180) = G
    - How Received IRN (FS190) = District A
    - Legal District of Residence (FS150) = District A
  - District A reports
    - Sent Reason (FS200) = OE
    - Sent To IRN (FS210) = District C
  - District B does not report

# Non-foster, Non-court Placement

- ▶ No court involvement
- ▶ Between county agency and family
- ▶ How Received (FS180) – Option J
- ▶ Example – resident of District A, county JFS placed to District B
  - District B reports
    - How Received (FS180) = J
  - District A reports
    - Sent Reason (FS200) = FC
- ▶ Also used when placed within resident district

# Court Placed Out of State

- ▶ Resident student court placed out of state and resident district required to pay cost of education
- ▶ Sent Reason (FS200) – Option CO
- ▶ Sent To IRN (FS210) = 999999
- ▶ Sent To Percent of Time (FS250) = 0

- ▶ New Retained Status (FN070) option
  - N – TGRG not met, not retained, iReady Alternative Assessment
- ▶ CTE Program of Concentration (FN290) option
  - N4 – Cybersecurity
- ▶ Military Compact Graduation Alternative Count (FN310)
  - Valid options now 0-7
- ▶ Military Student Identifier (FN430) option
  - C – Reserves

- ▶ CTFL-004 reports released 3/20/19
  - ▶ Latest addition of approved appeals
- ▶ Kids added to reporting via concentrator appeal will appear on missing list if no GV record reported

# FY19 CTE March (D) Follow-up Appeals

- ▶ For correcting survey result reporting errors as of close of regular collection
- ▶ Example
  - GV record reported with incorrect survey result
- ▶ **Not** for
  - Adding concentrators to file
  - Updating Program of Concentration for kids in file

- ▶ All elements must match
  - ▶ Subject Code (CN050)
  - ▶ Curriculum Code (CN310)
  - ▶ Delivery Method (CN320)
  - ▶ Educational Option (CN330)
  - ▶ Student Population (CN340)
  - ▶ Employee ID (CU050)
- ▶ Can help resolve CS0004 result codes

# CTE-26 Adjustments

- ▶ Only courses that align to an approved CTE-26 pathway generate CTE funding
- ▶ Two adjustments for courses in pathways with no approval, CTE FTE adjusted to zero
  - CS0020 – Workforce Development Course Not Approved by Office of CTE
  - CS0024 – Senior Only Credential Not Approved by Office of CTE
- ▶ Start working now to ensure funding next year

- ▶ Uses full academic year criteria to determine level of inclusion in report card measures
  - ▶ Percent Proficient
  - ▶ Annual Measurable Objectives (AMO)
  - ▶ Performance Index
  - ▶ Improving At-Risk K-3 Readers
- ▶ Some student data factors as of March 31
  - ▶ District Relationship (FS140)
  - ▶ Student Percent of Time (FS120)
  - ▶ How Received (FS180)
  - ▶ Sent Reason (FS200, FS230)

# Full Academic Year (FAY)

- ▶ Friday of first full week of October through spring testing
- ▶ A student who was continuously enrolled during this timeframe has met FAY
  - ▶ Building or district level
- ▶ Reported as Majority of Attendance IRN (FN220)

# Majority of Attendance IRN

- ▶ Reported by traditional districts, community schools, STEM districts, and ESCs
- ▶ Valid options
  - ▶ \*\*\*\*\* – Untested or FAY not met
  - ▶ Building IRN – FAY met at building
  - ▶ District IRN – FAY met at district
- ▶ Begin verifications in local software prior to end dates

# MOA IRN Exceptions

Resident/sending districts report as though student enrolled/attending their building

- College Credit Plus, Sent Reason PS
- Attending a Board of DD, Sent Reason MR
- Attending a JVSD, Sent Reason JV
- Contract Career-Tech, Sent Reason CT
- Non-public at district expense, Sent Reason NP
- Attending a state school, Sent Reason OS
- ESC school-age students, regular student reporting

  - Assists with data verification
- ▶ Additional filters applied at ODE not on report

- ▶ Result Code WK0002
- ▶ WKC IRN set to Accountability IRN
- ▶ Severity = Informational
- ▶ Example: Students with disabilities attend a building where special ed program is housed
  - District wants them to count at building they would attend if not special ed
  - Report that building's IRN as Accountability IRN

- ▶ Result Code WK0005
- ▶ WKC IRN set to \*\*\*\*\* for students served reported with
  - Percent of time > 0%
  - How Received = P, Q, or T
- ▶ Severity = Informational
- ▶ Still required to report MOA IRN based on FAY met/not met

- ▶ WKC IRN set to How Received IRN
- ▶ Severity = Informational
- ▶ Student counts in resident/sending district for
  - Percent proficient
  - Performance index
  - Attendance rate
- ▶ Student counts in educating district for
  - Participation rate

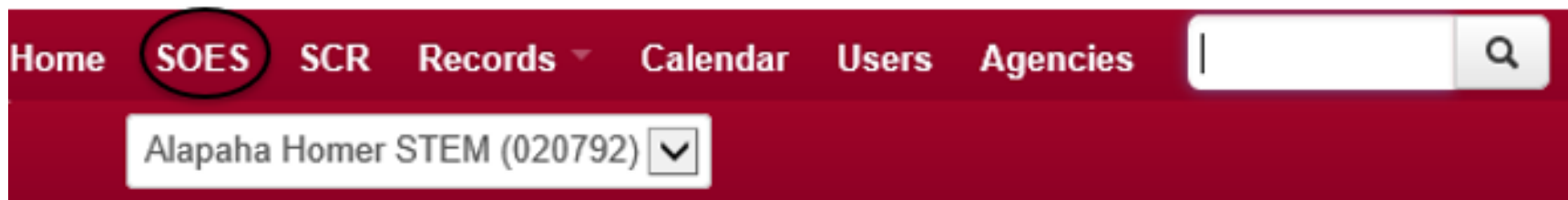
# Gen Issues

- ▶ IS0027 – MOA roll-up to the state
- ▶ 20% or more students with \*\*\*\*\* reported for Majority of Attendance IRN
  - ▶ Counting at the state
- ▶ Corresponds with Result Code WK0004
  - ▶ Severity = Warning
- ▶ Check accuracy of Majority of Attendance IRN reporting



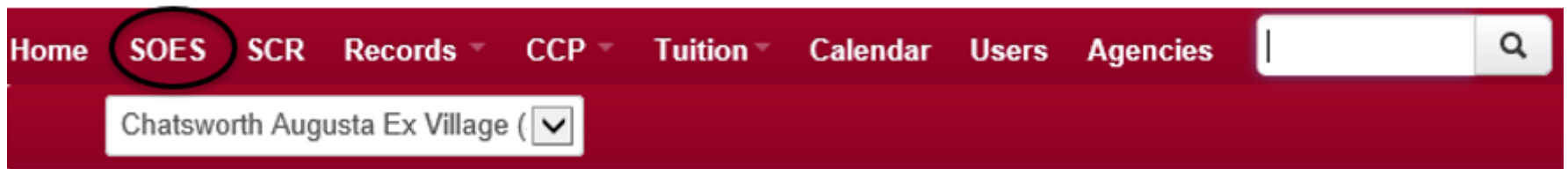

# Resident Review Screen

## Most flags impact funding



- Data Quality does not

### Status Flags

- Documented challenge: Select if the resident district has documentation that a student's address is not within the territory of the district or that the parent is not residing in the district.
- Data quality issue: Enter comments to provide clarification to the community school. It will not impact funding to the community school & should be used to address common data quality issues such as address mismatches.
- SSID mismatch: SSID reported by the community school differs from the one on file at the district.
- Graduated: Resident district believes that a student already has graduated from high school.
- Guardianship challenge: Student is in a guardianship situation & the resident district reported by the community school is not the correct district where the parent resides or resided per Ohio law or in accordance with a court order.
- Homeless challenge: District of residence assigned to a homeless student is challenged.

- ▶ Auto approval – requires comment, icon appears 14 days later
- ▶ Aged out – icon appears once status reached
- ▶ Approved with no errors – icon appears 75 days after approval

  - ▶ Will age out if no further action taken
